Foot Ball

The 1980 Bulldog Football Team was a vastly improved team, turning an 0-3 start into a 3-4 final record. Trexler was a team that experienced countless injuries, seriously crippling the total effort.

Trexler's forte was it's defense, led by Dave Hower and Mark Gaffney, which recorded three shutouts and allowed a single touchdown in yet another game. The offense was shaky at times, but showed potential when they were relatively healthy.

This is the last season that football will be played in the junior highs, and Trexler's final season certainly was nothing to be ashamed of.

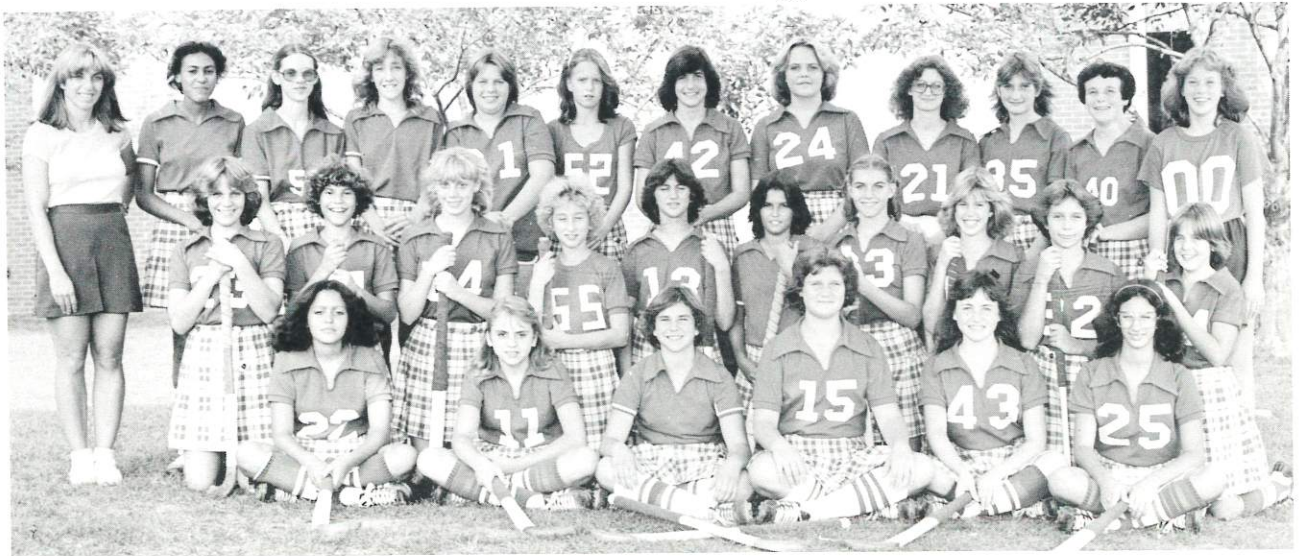
Field Hockey

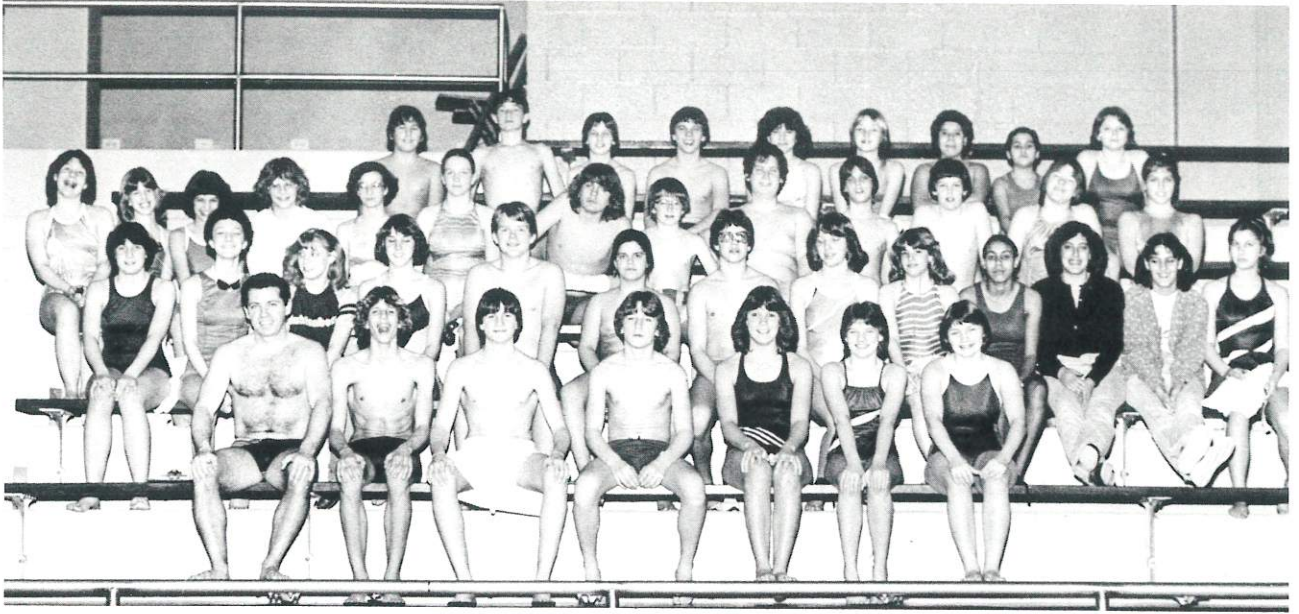
Gymnastics

Track

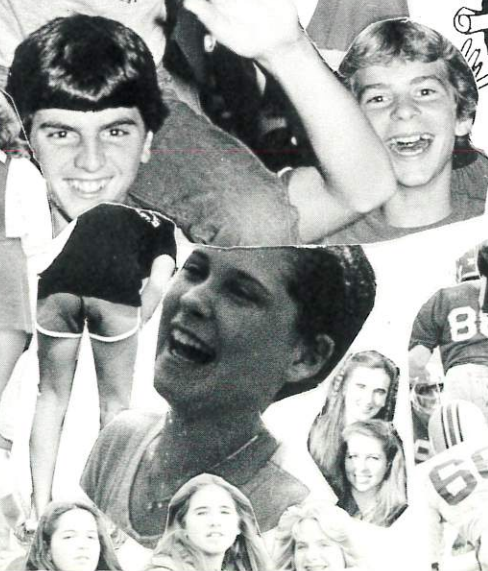
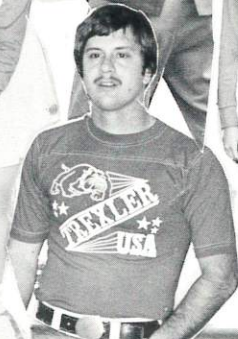
The track team of Trexler has not enjoyed much success in recent years, but for the first time in a while the feeling at Trexler seems to point towards a winning season.

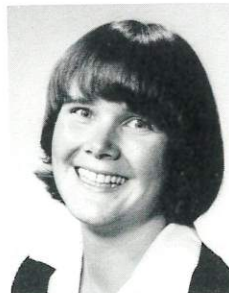
